Festivals and Competitions

Dance, Drama and Singing Festivals

Top Hat Theatre School like to take part in a number of local competitions each year students that wish to enter can compete against other schools wihtin singing, drama and dance. These discilipens can be solo, duos, trios or grops.

Festival sections are group into age range and the piece they are performing, they are marked by an independent adjudicator that grades and gives written feedback on your childs performance. They wukk tgen be presented first second, thris and sometimes there may be a fourth place.

Festivals help your child to build their confidence, especially in performing. To allow them to show their personality within dance, drama and singing and to show the skills they have learnt in their chosen piece.

Twirling Competitions

Top Hat Twirlers regularly compete at various competitions throughout the country, and especially with their background in dance have shown themnselves to be very succesful! Atheletes are grouped into age and ability sections and compete in a range of discipens from solo, duo and group. Succesful atheletes are often warded trophies for podium places $(1^{st} - 3^{rd})$ medals for 4th to 7th place and certificates for 8th to 10th.

Top Hat Twirlers brought home the metal at Area Competition!

Nineteen of our Twirlers travelled to Norfolk to take part in the competition which was a qualifier for the National Championships in Crawley at Easter. Everyone performed fantastically and the entire troupe came away with a total of 52 trophies, 18 medals and 5 certificates between them, with everyone qualifying for the championships!
